EXPLANATORY NOTES:

1. Great care must be taken by Grade 10 learners when deciding on subject choices in view of the National Senior Certificate examination. The school psychologist will make certain recommendations based on ability and previous achievements. Parents must confirm the final subject choice.
2. Certain subjects can only be taken under certain conditions, eg. if a learner takes Physical Science, Accounting or Engineering Graphics & Design, he/she must take Mathematics and may not take Mathematical Literacy. If a learner takes Civil Technology, he/she must also take Mathematics, Physical Science and Engineering Graphics & Design.
3. The availability of subjects depends on the number of learners who want to take the subject. If there are too few or too many learners who want to take a subject, it may happen that a learner will have to take an alternative subject.
